## Dear Potential Candidate:

The enclosed candidate form is provided for the following available positions being elected at the NCS USBCA Annual Meeting on May 18, 2019 at the Hawthorne Conference Center, 420 High Street SW, Winston-Salem, NC 27101. The positions up for election this year are:

Sgt At Arms, NCS USBCA (one position – three-year term)
Director NCS USBCA #7, #8, #11 (three positions – three-year term)
Youth Director #12 (one position – one-year term)
Delegates to the 2020 USBC National Convention (two positions and two alternate positions – one-year term)

All Adult and Youth Delegates vote for all positions.

- The forms for **all** positions have been combined into one composite form. You may apply for more than one position on the application form. Please make sure you mark the correct position(s) for which you want to be a candidate.
- To be listed on the candidate slate, you must postmark the submitted form no later than <u>January 14, 2019.</u> To be nominated from the floor, a candidate's credentials must be submitted 14 days prior to the opening of the annual meeting (May 4, 2019).
- To serve on the NCS USBCA Board of Directors, you must be a member of the Registered Volunteer Program or have applied for Registered Volunteer Program status.
- There will be a "Meet the Candidates" forum on Saturday May 18, 2019 prior to the elections. All qualified candidates are invited to participate, whether slated on the ballot or running from the floor.

We are looking for candidates who will bring expertise in one or more of the following areas: leadership skills, knowledge of local/state/national bylaws and rules, computer experience, finance experience, organizational skills, ability to resolve problems, dependability, accountability, communications/public speaking/people skills, marketing/promotional experience, confidentiality, and being a part of the NCS USBCA "team".

Potential candidates must be able to prove they support the sport of bowling by actions, and that they will represent the state association and its policies without any personal agenda.

It is a necessity that you are an adult or youth bowler who believes you can provide a **positive** contribution to the NCS USBCA, support its mission and values, and represent the state association in its workings with local associations.
